
2. Who Is HHI Audubon?



Hundreds of visitors per month








4. What <u>Is</u> the Christmas Bird Count (CBC)








4. What <u>Is</u> the Christmas Bird Count (CBC)



- Conducted 1 day during Dec 14th -Jan 5th
- Bird count is declining rapidly.... more research is underway

HHI Audubon Christmas Bird Count

- HHI 2020 Count:
 - Socially distanced!
 - 19 team captains
 - Field teams & home birders
- Tentative 2020 results:
 - Participants: 349
 - Species: 135
 - Birds 26,475
- 2019 HHI Audubon had a 246 participants: 4th highest of 2646 counts




