The overarching goal of this program is to provide an opportunity to vulnerable and underserved children through arts integration. Through this program, 161 Beaufort County 1st-12th grade

students with disabilities will create three to four visual arts projects during the school year using a variety of media, methods and lessons with the theme "Art Around the World."

In addition, approximately 20 Beaufort County teachers will participate in a professional development workshop to learn best practices in art lessons for students with disabilities. The 2024 WAHHI grant helps bridge the school district's educational gaps by exposing children to art, which in turn helps children hone problem solving skills.
