A WAHHI Charitable Grant 2024 of \$5,000 was awarded to The Children's Center Inc. February 21, 2024. Our grant will fund five families for a full year of tuition assistance for their infant children. This means a weekly discount for these families, which can make the difference between returning to work and dropping out of the workforce for the parents, usually mothers. WAHHI's support allows the Children's Center to continue to provide opportunities to give infants bright beginnings and a lifetime love of learning.

The Children's Center serves families with children ages six weeks to eight years. Their full day program serves children from infant to Pre-K, and their afterschool and summer camp programs are for children in Kindergarten through grade two. They serve all working families and their children across the Lowcountry. Eighty-five percent of their families qualify for assistance based on federal free and reduced lunch standards.
